Walking with the contradictions

v3 I will not travel with you

v14 I will personally travel with you

v11 The Lord would speak to Moses face to face

v 20 You cannot look directly at my face

Why the Change?

- The people repented, v4
- Moses sought God, v8
- A younger generation 'lingered' in God's presence, v11
- Moses received revelation, v14
- A resolve and commitment, v15
- Moses was still not satisfied, v18
- God knew how much Moses could cope with, v21

Where is BCF in the journey?

- Have we sufficient sense of our promised land?
